劇目改編自查爾斯・狄更斯之原著,創作團隊希望盡可能保留作者的觀點,還有小說中充滿力量的語言。故事講述一位年輕女士露茜・梅尼特要在薛尼・卡爾頓和查爾斯・達尼,兩位性格南轅北轍,卻同於政治變革漩渦中被捕的年青男士中作出取捨。

劇目以貪婪、權力濫用、人性的善惡作主題,帶出一個誠實 正直的人,於社會巨變下恐懼不安之際,在背叛、希望與愛 中周旋的故事。

This adaptation is based very closely on the original novel by Charles Dickens because the team wanted to keep Dickens' powerful language and his vision as much as possible. It is the story of Lucie Manette, a young woman, who has to choose between two young men of different characters, Sydney Carton and Charles Darnay, both were caught in the whirlpool of political change.

With the themes of greed, misuse of power, and good and evil, this is an exciting story of innocent people caught in the horrors of a changing society and challenged by betrayal, hope and love.
