紅玫瑰蘭卡斯特家族及白玫瑰金雀花王朝因貪婪及權力鬥爭引發玫瑰之戰。三位女皇憑著智慧與抱負,在這場英倫史上的著名角力擔當重要角色。

《玫瑰之戰》由倫敦音樂及戲劇藝術學院戲劇總監 Rodney Cottier 來港執導,歷屆 Bravo! 香港青年劇場獎勵計劃畢業生及專業演員傾力演出,演繹三位女皇的心路歷程。經典莎劇活現香港舞臺,長近一世紀的英國歷史戰爭,誰勝誰負,即將揭曉!

Margaret Anjou, Elizabeth Woodville and Anne Neville are the three powerful women who all reigned as Queen of England during the bloody civil wars in England in the 15th century known as the Wars of the Roses.

Behind the scenes, bold and passionate Margaret, quiet and scheming Elizabeth and tragic pawn Anne cast their power and dominance over their Kings, shaping the events directly in the bloody dynastic battles between the Lancastrian Red Rose and the Plantagenet White Rose.

Explore their stories as they unfold over the course of Shakespeare's four plays: *Henry VI*Parts I, II and III, and Richard III, each one full of intrigue, complexity and violence. Join us
to unlock the legends behind these powerful women in their desire for power and influence.

Rodney Cottier

Rodney Cottier 於倫敦音樂及戲劇藝術學院 (LAMDA),英國歷史最悠久的戲劇學院擔任戲劇總監。除了在LAMDA擔任舞臺總監、舞臺搏擊、演技和文本導師逾40年,Rodney 更曾執導26齣莎士比亞劇目。另外,他亦在北美洲的頂尖大學(35個州的165所大學及戲劇團體)舉行巡迴工作坊,教授莎劇合集《第一對開本》。Rodney身為動作大師,同時是莎士比亞環球劇場的動作指導,為不同劇目設計動作,包括Mark Rylance 版本的《王子復仇記》,還有皇家歌劇院、英國及威爾士國家歌劇院的製作。他也是LAMDA享負盛名的三年制專業演技課程畢業生。

Rodney is Head of the Drama School division at the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art (LAMDA) – UK's oldest drama conservatory. With 40 years' experience as a stage director and teacher of stage combat, acting and text at LAMDA, he has directed 26 plays from Shakespeare's canon. Rodney has also conducted an annual workshop tour of top North American universities (165 universities & theatre companies in 35 states), focusing on Shakespeare's First Folio. As a fight director,



Rodney has worked at Shakespeare's Globe as Master-of-Fight, choreographing several productions including Mark Rylance's *Hamlet*, as well as at the Royal Opera House, English and Welsh National Opera. Rodney is an alumnus of LAMDA'S flagship Three Year Professional Acting Course.

Heather Grayson

Heather曾自編自演獨角戲After the Storm,在紐約及美國巡演。此外,她在美期間出演過不同舞臺作品,例如莎劇《皆大歡喜》的Rosalid及主演《王子復仇記》。百老匯以外,她亦曾出演 Even Steven、Escape from Happiness、《馬克白》、《約翰王》及 A Town Called Shame。Heather最喜歡的演出作品包括:《威尼斯商人》、《異教徒之戀》和《達爾文之後》。Heather曾在紐約市擔任聲樂及口條教練,直至2011年移居香港。在PlayMakers劇團期間,她向大學生教授聲樂,同時師承NancyLane學習 戲劇 (中央演講 和戲劇學院畢業生和帝勢藝術學院導師)。

Along with several New York runs and a US tour of her one-woman show After the Storm, Heather's other NYC theater credits include Rosalind in As You Like It, and the title role in Hamlet, the off-Broadway run of Even Steven, Escape from Happiness, Macbeth, King John and the original cast of A Town Called Shame. Favorite stage credits: The Merchant of Venice, Dancing at Lughnasa, and After Darwin. Heather was a dialect/vocal coach in NYC before moving to Hong Kong in 2011. While at UNC's



PlayMakers Repertory Company, she taught voice to undergraduates while studying under Nancy Lane (who studied at the Royal Central School of Speech and Drama and taught at Tisch School of the Arts).

Bravo! 香港青年劇場獎勵計劃

Hong Kong Youth Theatre Awards Scheme

Bravo!香港青年劇場獎勵計劃是歷時一年半的雙語戲劇及生命教育計劃,橫跨香港、台北及倫敦的由本地及倫敦音樂及戲劇學院(LAMDA)導師為參加者提供免費專業演戲訓練,包括形體劇場和經典劇場對象為具戲劇天分的13-18歲學生。計劃於2013年開始,一直由利希慎基金為策略伙伴及贊助並由LAMDA和台北雲門舞集舞蹈教室擔任學習伙伴。本計劃在過去四屆轉化了128名畢業生的人生,第四屆Bravo!及此製作更獲得香港特別行政區政府「藝能發展資助計劃」的躍進資助。是次青年劇場演出由歷屆Bravo!畢業生聯同專業演員出演。

Bravo! is an award-winning bilingual acting and lifeskills scheme based in Hong Kong, Taipei and London offering 1.5 years' professional training on classic theatre and physical theatre to 13-18 year-old students with acting talents. Since the programme started in 2013, Lee Hysan Foundation has been the Strategic Partner & Sponsor while the prestigious London Academy of Music & Dramatic Art (LAMDA) and Cloud Gate Dance School in Taipei have been the overseas learning partners. The fourth cohort and this production are financially supported by the Springboard Grant under the Arts Capacity Development Funding Scheme of the Government of HKSAR. The scheme has brought life changing experiences to 128 graduates in the past 4 cohorts. The Young Company production is performed by Bravo! graduates & professional actors.
